### **Church Council Minutes**

March 5, 2023

**Present:** Pastor Liz, Deb Gehrke, Tom Christensen, Jim Grabow, Ginny Grabow, Terri Heimerman, Julie Rogers Pastor Liz opened the meeting with prayer.

Secretary's report: January council minutes and the minutes of the Annual Meeting were approved.

**Election of Officers:** President--Deb Gehrke, Vice President--Tom Christensen, Secretary—Ginny Grabow. All members of the council were installed at worship today.

### Financial Report: (Brian Block)

• The general fund received gifts of \$20,385.30 versus last year of \$16,666.60, a difference of 3,718.70. The checkbook balance is \$14,087.89. Tom Christensen, motion to approve, Julie Rogers seconded. Approved.

### **Old Business:**

- Soup & Sandwich suppers during Lent--Only one person responded to the query on Lenten soup & sandwich suppers. We will discuss reinstating these Lenten suppers next year.
- Easter—9:00 Easter worship service. 8:15 kids egg hunt and coffee and rolls served before service.
- Synod Assembly, May 6. We have one female volunteer. Still need a male representative.
- Church Events calendar will be finalized. Looking forward to spring outdoor clean-up in April, when the mountains of snow will be melted!
- God Squad is doing a service project this week. These sessions for our children will be done for this year after Easter.
- Daytime Adult Bible Study & conversation will be revisited in the fall.
- Care packages for our college students will be done before end of this school year. A sign up for members of the congregation to supply items needed for the packages will be posted.
- Adopt A Highway clean up should happen before the ditches grow, making it hard to find the litter. Dates and times will be
  posted in the newsletter and weekly bulletin.
- Additions to our church family--We will be welcoming several new members soon.
- Project List—for the church and parsonage will be prioritized by the council, so that the most pressing items are done first.

### **New Business:**

- Deb shared that there are several adjustments that need to be made to the membership list as it was presented at the annual meeting.
- The February 12 Souper Sunday/games event was a success with many delicious soups and 20+ people who enjoyed this fellowship time.
- Ricoh duplicator is installed and being used weekly.
- Online worship on Facebook didn't work today. There were complications with Facebook. There was a discussion on presenting our worship services online. We have made the investment in equipment and internet access. We discussed other options to carry our services, such as posting it on our website, where we don't have to depend on Facebook to carry it. Scott Lassiter will be invited to our next meeting to participate in the discussion of other options. Tabled until our next meeting.
- Spring Yard Sale—We are planning to host a yard sale on the same day as the Cleveland City-Wide sale. Members are asked to add any clean, usable items they would like to donate in advance of the sale. Watch the newsletter and bulletin for additional information.
