Church Council Minutes

Tuesday, June 11, 6:30

Present: Pastor Liz, Tom Christensen, Terri Heimerman, Julie Rogers, Jim Grabow, Ginny Grabow.

A devotional was presented by Ginny.

Financial report by Brian: The general fund received gifts of \$8547.68 versus last year of \$9,422.51 giving us a difference of (\$874.90). Year to date the general fund received gifts of \$50,985.58 versus last year's \$49,530.33, giving us a difference of \$1,455.25. The checkbook balance if \$8,619.48. Motion to approve April & May financials made by Terri, second by Tom. Motion passed.

Minutes of the May council meeting were approved via email.

Old Business

• Julie asked about internet provider MetroNet. Jim reported that a meeting by a project manager for the company did not take place. They are working to bury cable all over Cleveland and we expect they will be working on our connection.

New Business

- Adjustments were made to the Events Calendar and the Project List. The parsonage living room carpet will be replaced by vinyl plank flooring this summer. Pastor will contribute to the cost.
- Several possibilities for summer fellowship events were discussed. Adult VBS at Gaylord on June 17, Beer & Hymns on July 22 at The Bar in LeSueur. August 9 jazz event at St. Peter's MN Square Park. Uccellino playing, 7:00-8:30. Watch for further information.
- We are looking at the possibility to add leave policies to our constitution. These would include Sabbatical Leave for pastors and family medical leave. Pastor Liz will explore policies already established by churches and report back to council. Should either of these needs arise in the future, it will be an advantage to have procedures in place. Motion for further exploration of leave policies by Pr. Liz was made by Terri, seconded by Ginny. Motion passed.
- Discussion of low attendance at church—why? And what can be done to encourage attendance at worship?
- God's Work Our Hands Sunday will take place in September. Possible service projects were discussed.
 One idea was to contact Crossroads Lutheran Campus Ministry (Pr Jenna Couch) about the lack of food resources for college students. They sponsor Lunch for a Buck on Wednesdays. This would be a project close to home that would fill a definite need.

Next meeting: July 14 after worship. Closed with The Lord's Prayer. Meeting adjourned. Ginny Grabow, council secretary
